<b>Bil</b> 1	Item	<ul> <li>Terms &amp; Conditions</li> <li>a) The Digital Street Vendor Grant (Geran Digital Penjaja Madani) is an initiative provided by the Ministry of Finance Malaysia in collaboration with Bank Simpanan Nasional (BSN), Malaysia Digital Economy Corporation Sdn Bhd (MDEC), and the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) to assist street vendors in utilizing digital services in their daily business operations ("Initiative").</li> <li>b) This Initiative is offered to street vendors under the Madani Budget 2023 to access digital services from appointed service providers.</li> <li>c) The Ministry of Finance Malaysia, through BSN as the disbursing bank, has allocated a sum of RM1,000.00 (Malaysian Ringgit: One Thousand Ringgit) only for each eligible street vendor from the total invoices received from the appointed service providers for the implementation of digitalization processes and other services listed within this</li> </ul>	
2	Amount	Initiative. The grant amount for each vendor is RM1,000.00 (Malaysian Ringgit: One Thousand Ringgit) only and will be directly paid to the appointed digital service provider.

	otherwise. BSN, MDEC, and MCMC shall not be responsible
	for any breach of obligations under this Initiative caused by
	force majeure events, including but not limited to natural
	disasters, wars, civil unrest, blockades, industrial actions,
	epidemics, pandemics, fires, floods, droughts, storms, or any
	events beyond the reasonable control of BSN, MDEC, and
	MCMC.
e)	BSN reserves the absolute discretion to amend, modify,
,	cancel, or add to any of these Terms and Conditions, in whole
	or in part, subject to any changes in government policies, by
	providing prior notice of at least twenty-one (21) calendar days
	before the amendment, modification, cancellation, or addition
	takes effect through notification by any means of
